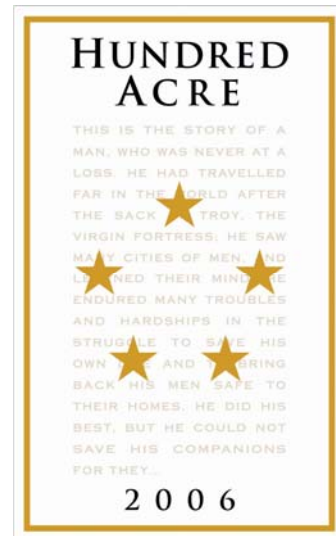


# HUNDRED ACRE

### **HUNDRED ACRE CABERNET SAUVIGNON KAYLI MORGAN VINEYARD, NAPA VALLEY 2006**

#### **99 POINTS**

“The 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Kayli Morgan Vineyard has turned out brilliantly. Like its siblings, it exhibits a deep ruby/purple color, low acidity, incredibly sweet, ripe tannins, and notes of melted chocolate, kirsch liqueur, and a hint of cassis. Opulent, intense, and full-bodied with fabulous fruit purity and depth, this is a tour de force in winemaking. It is unquestionably one of the wines of the vintage. It will drink well for fifteen plus years.” RP

### **HUNDRED ACRE CABERNET SAUVIGNON ARK VINEYARD, HOWELL MOUNTAIN, NAPA VALLEY 2006**

#### **96 POINTS**

“...tannins and earthiness are apparent in the 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Ark Vineyard. Last year, this wine revealed considerable softness, but that has morphed into a more delineated, beautifully dense, extravagant fruit character. It, too, should drink beautifully for 20 years.” RP
