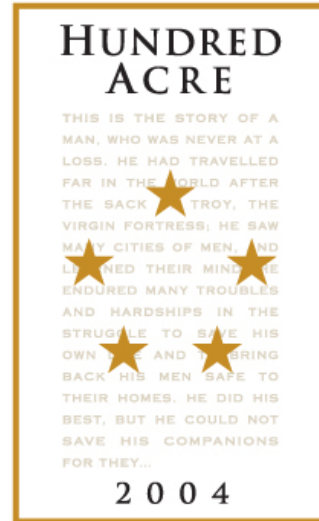


HUNDRED ACRE

"The 2004 Cabernet Sauvignon Kayli Morgan is beautifully broad, savory, and full-bodied, and even though it is all Cabernet Sauvignon, it always comes across like exotic Merlot from Pomerol, especially the famed Le Pin. Seductive and sensual, with notes of cedar, sweet kirsch, graphite, and spice, the wine is full-bodied, layered, gorgeously plump, and thrilling to drink now and over the next 10-15 years. It is French in style, but with an exuberance and gorgeous fruit purity of Napa Cabernet Sauvignon." -RP
