StoneCap is made with estate-grown grapes from the expansive and renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This highly regarded vineyard allows winemaker Kendall Mix and the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "Stonecap" of rocks behind.
