Our 2009 Estate Riesling is pleasing with aromatics of lavender and other floral notes. Full of fresh fruit flavors like white peach and lychee fruit that intermingle with hints of honey and citrus. Rich and refreshing, this wine pairs well with spicy Asian Foods, creamy cheese, poultry, seafood and grilled fish.

StoneCap is made with estate-grown grapes from the expansive and renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This highly regarded vineyard allows winemaker Kendall Mix and the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

Washington State's famed Columbia Valley produces extraordinary grapes in large part due to the area's great soils, the result of massive flooding during the last Ice Age. Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "Stonecap" of rocks behind.
