## **20 To Watch - Exciting New Cabernet Labels**

**“The only non-Napa label to make this list,** Hidden Ridge Vineyard lies between Mt. Hood and Diamond Mtn. in the Mayacamas range on the Napa and Sonoma border. **Marco DiGiulio is the winemaker** working with 55 acres planted in 21 blocks, all on rugged terrain and steep slopes. *‘You feel like you’re falling off the end of the earth,’* says DiGiulio about the drive in.

Owners Lynn Hofacket and Casidy Ward planted the vineyard over the past decade. *‘It’s one of those vineyards that you just have to see to believe,’* says DiGiulio.”

“Bold, ripe and concentrated, with intense, perfumed plum and blackberry fruit that’s well-centered and well-proportioned, finishing with firm tannins.” J. Laube, October 2007

“Intense, rich and concentrated, with ripe, well-defined fruit built around ripe currant, blackberry and wild berry and framed by firm, chewy tannins. Shows of spicy, toasty oak...” J. Laube, July 2007

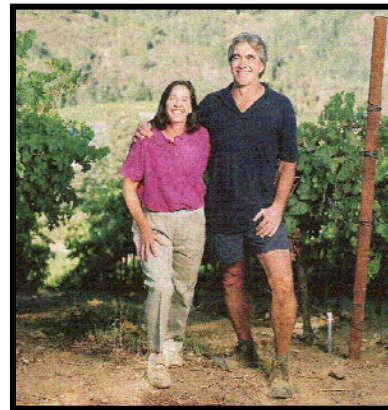
