Our 2010 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is rich and robust. Black cherry, raspberry and currants combine with toasty oak and spice. Pair with grilled steak and herb-roasted rack of lamb.

StoneCap is made with estate-grown grapes from the expansive and renowned Goose Ridge Vineyard in Washington State's Columbia Valley. This highly regarded vineyard allows the winemaking team of Justin Michaud and Kendall Mix and the Monson Family to produce stunning quality wines while remaining sensibly priced.

Washington State's famed Columbia Valley produces extraordinary grapes in large part due to the area's excellent soils, the result of massive flooding during the last Ice Age. Light and porous, these soils are frequently wind-blown and the windy tops of the many high hills and ridgelines of the region are typically devoid of soil, leaving a "Stonecap" of rocks behind.
