- Jeb Dunnuck: **94 points** – “... sexy notes of crème de cassis, lead pencil shavings, graphite, and tobacco, the 2018 Cabernet Sauvignon Napa Valley is full-bodied and has a terrific sense of minerality, ripe yet present tannins, beautiful purity, and a great finish. This comes from a mix of sites and was brought up in roughly 50% new French oak. It's a smoking value well worth snatching up...”
- Lisa Perrotti-Brown (Robert Parker): **94 points** - “...opens slowly to reveal iron ore, mossy tree bark, fragrant earth and lavender with a core of fresh black currants, red currants and Morello cherries plus wafts of oolong tea and black olives. Medium to full-bodied, firm and lively, it has an intense mid-palate of muscular fruit, finishing long and mineral laced.”
- Antonio Galloni, Vinous: **93 points** – “...is gorgeous. Juicy dark cherry, chocolate, spice, licorice and new leather are front and center in this bold Cabernet Sauvignon from Moone and Larry Tsai..”
