2008 Moone Tsai Cor Leonis, Napa Valley ~ 93 points Wine Spectator ~ *J.L.*

Deep and complex, with plush, concentrated currant, blackberry, mocha, mineral, sage and cedar flavors that are stacked on one another. Full-blown, with a long, tapered finish. Best from 2012 through 2022. 220 cases made.

2008 Moone Tsai Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley ~ 90 points Wine Spectator ~ *J.L.*

Firm and concentrated, with a layered mix of red berry, cedar, sage, mineral and tobacco. Full-bodied, ending on a long, persistent finish. Decant. Best from 2012 through 2020. 1,587 cases made

2008 Moone Tsai Howell Mountain Merlot ~ 93 points Wine Spectator ~ *T.F.*

A Merlot with great depth and focus, offering loamy black currant aromas and dense yet plush red currant, bittersweet chocolate and spicy cedar flavors. The tannins are firm but ripe. Needs time. Best from 2012 through 2017. 281 cases made.

2009 Moone Tsai Chardonnay, Napa Valley ~ 93 Points Wine Spectator ~ *J.L.*

Beautifully crafted, rich and layered, showing honeyed pear, butterscotch, fig and citrus note. Full-bodied and concentrated, with a long, persistent finish. Drink now through 2016. 403 cases made.
