

- 90 km NE of Adelaide
- Old Vine Character: Vines over 150 years
- Phylloxera free
- History back to the 1840's
- Community of family growers
- Mediterranean climate: Rain in winters and hot dry summers
- Tight temperature ranges ideal for full bodied reds and robust white wines
- Vintage February – March/April
- 13, 256 hectares of vineyard compared to other top wine regions: Burgundy 29,500 hectares, Napa Valley 18,200 hectares
- Well-draining soils, abundant sunshine, long warm days and cool nights with pure fresh water produce wine with intense flavour and long length.
