Heritage

Chateau Tanunda, Icon of the Barossa was established in 1890 and is the site of some of the Valley's earliest vines as well as its first winery. The Chateau is privately owned by the Geber family who continue a tradition of fine wine making spanning three centuries.

Vineyard

For our Grand Barossa wines, we select grapes grown throughout the Barossa. It is this tapestry of 'terroirs' which enables us to create our classic and refined house style.

By combining both traditional and modern winemaking techniques we are able to make handcrafted wines of complexity, depth and intensity.

Tasting note

Lifted aromas of blackberry, plum and black pepper are accompanied by spicy, dark berry fruits on the palate. The finish is long with fine – grained tannins, from maturation in a combination of new and seasoned American and French Oak barrels.
