This wine's deep ruby color with garnet hues exemplify the Bordeaux varietals within. Floral violets and bright red currants balance toasty vanilla oak and dark Damson plum. A juicy and elegant acidity opens to complex wood spices, giving this luxurious wine a youthful and beautifully proportioned palate that will only improve with time.
